



2006 SANTA CRUZ MOUNTAINS SYRAH, BLACK RIDGE VINEYARD



These grapes come from a carefully tended hillside vineyard in the Santa Cruz Mountains near Los Gatos. The wine was barrel aged in French oak for 14 months to provide additional structure and balance. This is an excellent example of what a coastal climate Syrah should be.

“The Black Ridge Vineyard Syrah has a lively interplay between fruit and spice aromas with cranberry, blackberry and dark cherry intertwining with scents of vanilla, brown sugar and wild mushrooms. Flavors of blueberry jam and sour cherry layered with spice box and cinnamon evoke bygone memories while the lush tannins allow this wine to complement hearty meat dishes. Your patience will be rewarded as this wine evolves in years to come.” – Greg Jenkins, Winemaker
