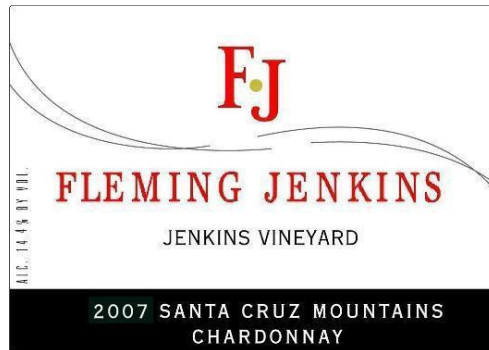




## 2007 SANTA CRUZ MOUNTAINS CHARDONNAY, JENKINS VINEYARD



The fruit for this wine was grown in our home vineyard, resting at 1,400 feet in the foothills of California's Santa Cruz Mountains above Los Gatos. Planted in 1999, there are approximately 650 vines on this sloping one-acre vineyard site that produced just over three tons of fruit for the 2007 harvest. The grapes were hand harvested early in the morning and transported directly to the winery in small picking lugs. They were then immediately whole cluster pressed and fermented and aged in French oak barrels.

*"The 2007 vintage Chardonnay showcases fresh apple blossom and tropical fruit aromas. On the palate there are flavors of crisp apple, pear and fig with nuances of melon and lemon. These flavors combine well with spice layers and rich texture provided by our careful use of oak to showcase the wine's depth and diversity.
